The Rebecca Skelton Fund for Dance, Research & Performance provides financial assistance towards the cost of postgraduate dance study in experiential/creative work to include dance improvisation and those training methods such as Skinner Releasing Technique, Alignment Therapy, Feldenkrais Technique, Alexander Technique and other body-mind practices that focus on an inner awareness and use the proprioceptive communication system or an inner sensory mode.

Awards in the region of £500, one deadline per year (last deadline: February 2014).

Lisa Ullman Travelling Scholarship Fund - www.lutsf.org.uk

LUTSF supports individuals working in all areas of movement and dance who wish to travel in order to enrich their practice and pursue a personal passion. Applications are welcomed from choreographers, performers, lecturers/teachers, writers, therapists, administrators and related professionals. The average scholarship in the last few years has been around £600, although very occasionally larger awards are made.

The Application Form is available on the LUTSF website from **1st September** each year. Completed applications are required by **25th January** of the following year for projects taking place between April of that year and April of the following year. Where January 25th is a Sunday, application forms must be received by the 24th.

This funding programme will support individuals to develop their skills and/or professional practice through specific activities, including, but not limited to:

- Attendance at conferences, seminars, festivals and other professional networking/ information sharing events.
- A structured programme of technical skills development.
- Attendance at and participation in workshops, master-classes or a residency to develop professional practice.
- Mentoring and shadowing opportunities.

Individual awards will be in the region of £1,000 - £5,000. Applications accepted throughout the year, 8 week turnaround. Must be a resident of Scotland and working in the arts/dance.
